WHAT TO BRING.....

- Sleeping bag and pillow (mountain nights get very cold)
- Wash cloths and towels
- Toilet articles (comb, soap, toothbrush, shampoo, etc.)
- Church groups: Complete Bible and pencil
- Sweater, sweatshirt, or jacket (heavy coat, gloves, and hat if winter time)
- Hiking boots or comfortable shoes
- Slippers for use in cabins and dining hall (helpful if muddy)
- Long pants and heeled boots or shoes for horseback riding (if applicable)
- Water bottle
- Sun protection, including hat or cap, sun block, sun glasses, lip balm (elevation 7000')
- Swimsuit if using waterslide (no two-piece suits - please be modest)
- Flashlight and batteries
- Spending money for the Sutler Store

WHAT NOT TO BRING.....

Pets, jewelry, expensive watches, cell phones, MP3 players, electronic game devices (We are trying to preserve our Western-type setting), bikini swimming suits, short shorts, firearms, knives, alcoholic beverages of any kind, smoking materials (Forest and Fire Marshall regulations), and **sad faces**.

LOST & FOUND items can be positively identified only if they are properly marked, and will be mailed home only upon request, with postage covered by the retreat guest. When you leave, check both the list of what came to camp and the Lost & Found box which is located in the dining hall. **A GOOD IDEA: PUT YOUR NAME ON EVERYTHING!**

CHILDREN'S AND YOUTH GROUPS: It is the group's responsibility to bring sufficient adult supervision. We recommend a minimum of 1:7 ratio of adult sponsors to youth. We require sponsors to stay in cabin rooms with campers. The sponsors are responsible for the actions and behavior of campers. Any damage done to Fort facilities or equipment through misuse will be charged to the sponsoring group and taken out of the damage deposit.

Where is Fort Lone Tree?

Fort Lone Tree is located 26 miles north of Ruidoso, New Mexico, 70 miles west of Roswell and 165 miles south of Albuquerque. From Capitan, go 4.2 miles north on Hwy 246 - Turn right at first Fort sign; go 2 miles east on County Rd 142 (not paved and not well-marked; follow the Fort signs). Turn left at the second Fort sign and follow the 1/2 mile winding road to Fort Lone Tree.
